is designed to assist eligible low-income households pay for energy services. The amount paid is determined by income, number of residents in a household, heating fuel source, and geographical location. The U.S. Department of Health and Human services funds LIHEAP.

- LIHEAP (one-time payment)
- · Crisis Heating Assistance
- Weatherization Assistance Program

Eligibility is determined by the current year's Federal poverty guidelines.
